

Noble SWCD Environmental Day Camp Information and Registration

Noble Soil and Water Conservation District is preparing to have its 27th annual Environmental Day Camp for kids aged 9 -12, on July 14th and 15th, at the Caldwell Lake Pavilion. Environmental Day Camp is designed to introduce youth to natural resource conservation, helping them understand how soil, water, trees, and wildlife all work together, and how they can play a role in protecting them. Throughout the two-day camp, participants will take part in a variety of hands-on outdoor activities that focus on conservation, wildlife stewardship, and outdoor skills.

On the first day of camp, participants will test their archery skills under the supervision of a certified instructor, learn how to identify different tree species, and explore the outdoors on a guided nature hike. Campers will also build their own bluebird houses, learning how simple conservation practices can support local bird populations. The day will also include group activities, crafts, and field games.

On the second day, campers will spend time on the water fishing and canoeing on Caldwell Lake with the assistance of a certified canoeing instructor. They will also participate in air gun safety and target practice under the guidance of a certified hunter safety instructor, with all appropriate safety equipment provided. These activities help reinforce safe, responsible outdoor recreation and an appreciation for natural resources.

The cost of Environmental Day Camp is \$35 per camper. This fee includes lunch for both days, a camp t-shirt, and all supplies for activities and take-home projects. Lunch on day one will include pizza, chips, cookies, watermelon, and a drink. Lunch on day two will include hot dogs, chips, a cookie, and a drink.

The camp is **limited to the first 30 participants ages 9–12**. Camp will run from **9:00am – 2:30pm** each day. To ensure your child's spot, be sure to register early.
